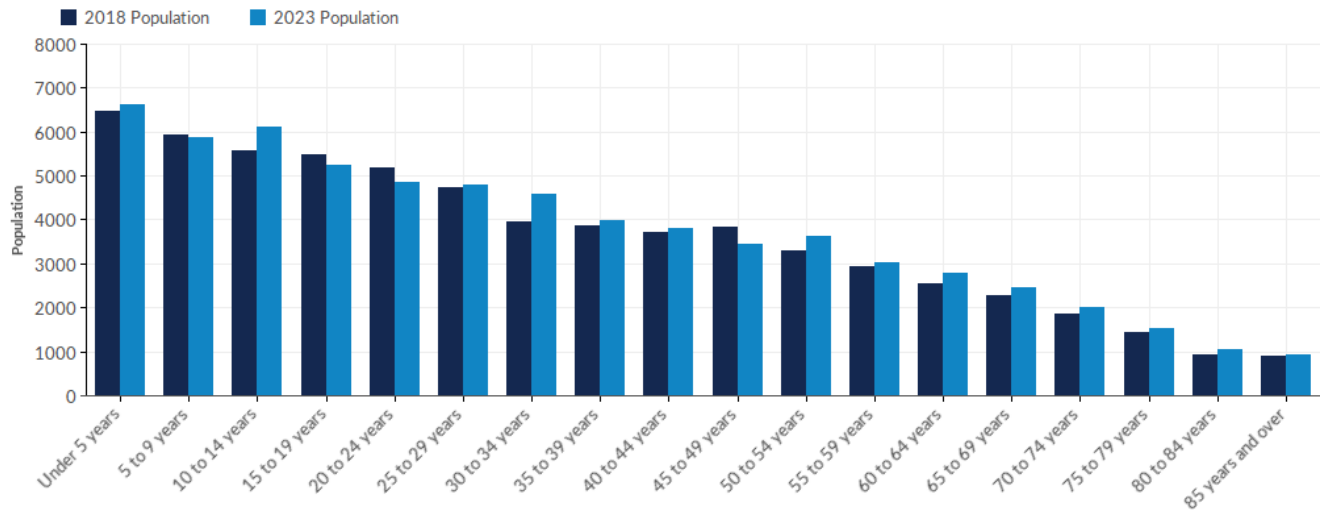

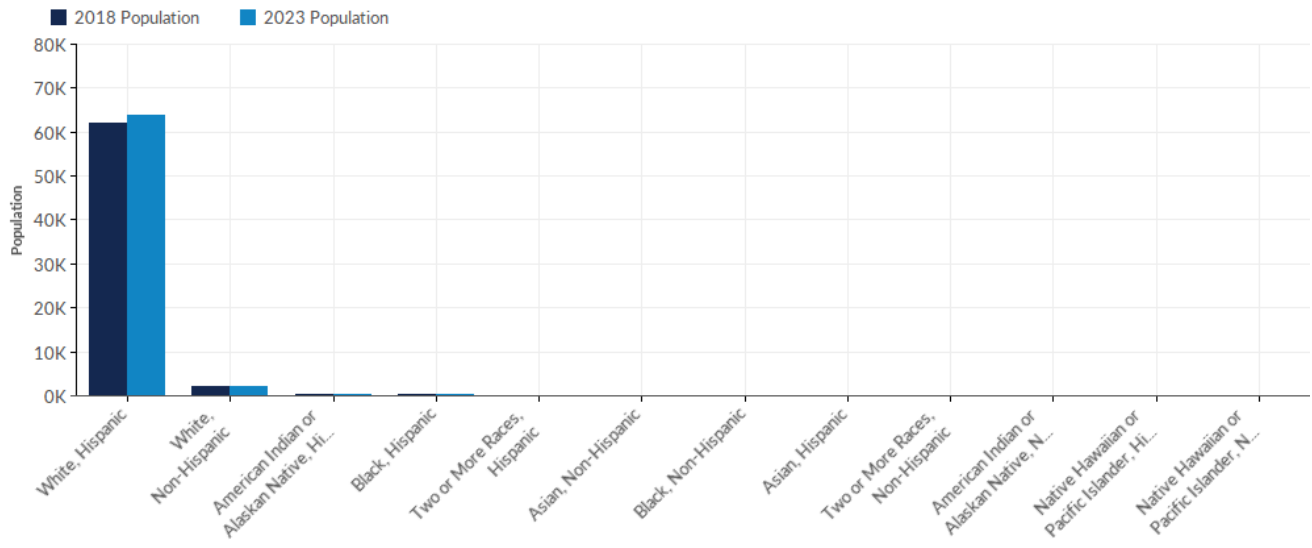

Population by Age Cohort



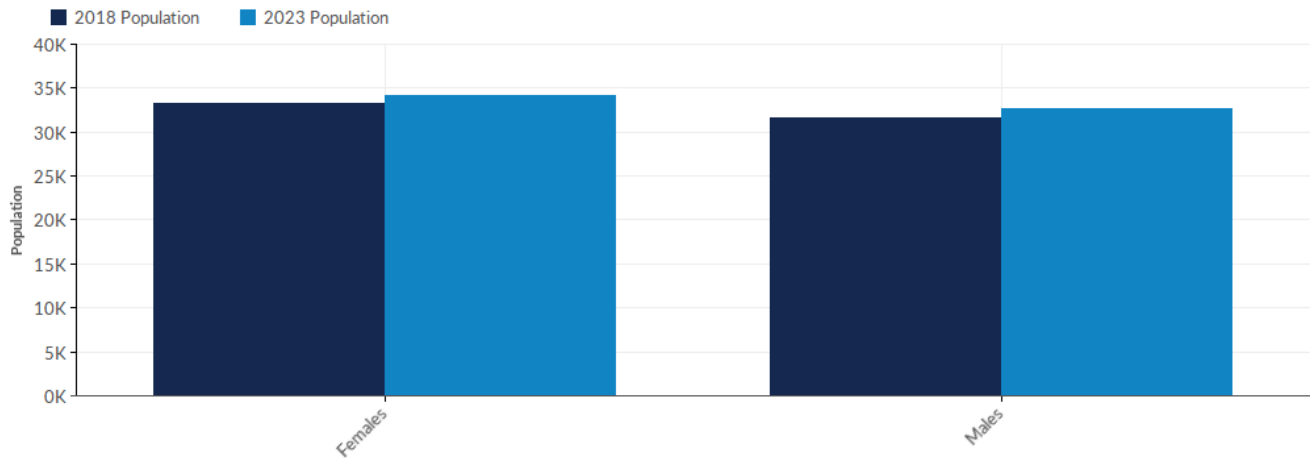
